This is the reason we are pleased to announce a clinical cases competition focusing on 360° IMPLANTOLOGY - Modern Technologies and Techniques in Clinical Practice. Clinicians are invited to submit their clinical cases, clinical procedures or clinical studies.

ELIGIBILITY

To submit an abstract, the following criteria must be met:

1. Preference will be given to cases using conical connection implants, as well as other MIS products.
2. The abstract should detail the patient's gender, age, relevant medical and dental history and treatment goal.
3. The written text should include no more than 5 sentences describing the treatment/ technical innovation in addition to the legends of the figures. Each figure should have a short description explaining the picture. Maximum of 30 figures.
4. The case should include pre & post-operative photographic and radiographic information, and all the relevant clinical steps (intra & extra-oral). If the treatment is in the esthetic zone, extraoral lower-face pictures and smile analysis should be included.

PARAMETERS FOR EVALUATION

- a. Logical and clear treatment plan/ technique.
- b. Logical validity and compatibility of the treatment steps.
- c. Treatment complexity.
- d. Quality of the surgical/prosthetic operations.
- e. Detailed relevant documentation.
- f. Photographic quality.
- g. Final results (clinical and radiographical).

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- A signed document confirming that:
 1. The treatment was performed by the clinician signing this document.
 2. The patient has approved usage by MIS of any photographs, radiographs and other materials for presentations, publications, etc.
- A one-paragraph CV of the clinician including age, place of work and professional education.
- Submission format - PDF or powerpoint files.

All cases will be reviewed and pre-approved by the contest scientific committee. You are requested to submit an abstract by October 30th, 2017 to the following email address : bahamascontest@mis-implants.com.

Please note that all abstracts must be in English.

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
